Cameroon Government obtained funding from the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD) to cover the cost of Commodity Value Chain Development Support Project – PHASE II PADFAII and plans to make partial use of that amount to recruit a consulting firm.

The consulting services ("the Services") include the determination of the favorable and unfavorable effects likely to be caused by the project on the environment. The study will make it possible to take measures aimed at mitigating, avoiding, eliminating or compensating for the harmful effects on the environment. The Far North and North Regions will be covered.

The mission, which takes effect from the date of service of the contract, will cover a period of ninety (90) days including the preparation, drafting and submission of progress reports, provisional and final documents, as well as the holding of validation workshops.

PADFA II now invites qualifying consulting firms ("Consulting Firms") to provide such services. Interested consulting firms are required to provide information showing that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to provide such services and submit it to the given address below.

We draw the attention of interested consulting firms to IFAD's Policy on Combating Money Laundering and the Financing of Terrorism and the Revised IFAD Policy on the Prevention of Fraud and Corruption in its activities and operations.

- (c) have a professional or family connection with a member of the client's Board of Directors or staff, with the Fund or its agents, or with anyone who took or could reasonably take part, directly or indirectly,, i) drafting up this call for expressions of interest (ii) the selection process for the concerned, contract or (iii) the execution of the latter. Consulting firms are at all times required to disclose any real, potential or reasonably conflict of interest situation that arises during the establishment of the expression of interest, the selection process or the execution of Non-disclosure of such situations may, inter alia, result in the exclusion of the consulting firm, termination of the contract or any other appropriate action pursuant to IFAD's Policy on the Prevention of Fraud and Corruption in its activities and operations.
