# 7. Main qualification criteria

## 7.1 Eliminatory Criteria

These include:

- The lack of handling within 48 hours after the opening of the bids, of a document from the administrative file deemed non-compliant or absent (except the bid bond);
- Fake declarations, fraudulent maneuvers or forged documents;
- Non satisfaction of at least 09/10 "Yes" of core criteria; 0
- Absence of the bid bond (in the case of a consortium, the bid bond must be in the name of the consortium); .
- Non-compliance of the technical specifications with the description of the supply;
- Absence of the IFAD self-certification form for the said service which is dated, initialed and signed.

## 7.2 Essential Criteria

- Similar references (02 references at least from similar contracts carried out during the last five years (through receipt report and first photocopies and signature page of the contract for a cumulative amount of 5,000, 000 (Five Million) CFA francs) (01 criterion);
