Cameroon Government has obtained funding from the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD) to cover the cost of the Commodity Value Chain Development

Support Project – PHASE II (PADFA II) and plans to make partial use of it to join advisory services.

The use of IFAD funds is subject to IFAD approval, subject to the terms and conditions set out in the financing agreement and in accordance with IFAD rules, policies and procedures. IFAD and its representatives, agents and officials are released from all liability for legal actions, proceedings, claims, demands, losses and obligations of any kind and of any nature that any party may invoke under PADFA II.

The consultancy services include the technical study for the establishment of four (04) modern rice and onion storage/sale facilities, which will be associated with a differentiated installation of facilities related to this type of investment in each of the modern installations in order to upgrade the preservation of the environment and the social valorization of these devices (access to water, electricity, rest rooms, garage space/breakdown, and so on.). The consultant will also provide the elements for the establishment of an efficient distribution channel for rice and onion products (seeds, raw and processed products) on the various targeted and competitive contracts.

The mission which takes effect from the date of notification of the contract will cover a period of ninety (90) days including the preparation, drafting, and submission of progress reports, provisional documents as well as the maintenance validation workshops.

PADFA II now invites expressions of interest from qualifying consulting firms ("Consulting Firms") to provide such services. Interested consulting firms are required to provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to provide these services and send it to the address provided below.

We draw the attention of interested consulting firms to IFAD's Policy on Combating Money Laundering and the Financing of Terrorism and the Revised IFAD Policy on the Prevention of Fraud and Corruption in its activities and operations. - c) have professional or family ties with a member of the management board of the purchaser or its personnel, with the Fund or its agents, or with anyone who has participated or may reasonably be expected to participate, directly or indirectly, in
- (i) the preparation of this call for expressions of interest,
- (ii) the selection process for the contract concerned, or
- (iii) the execution of the latter. Consulting firms are at all times required to report any real, potential or reasonably discernible conflict of interest situation that arises during the establishment of the expression of interest, the selection process or the execution of the contract. Non-disclosure of such situations may, inter alia, result in the exclusion of the consulting firm, termination of the contract or any other appropriate action pursuant to IFAD's Policy on the Prevention of Fraud and Corruption in its activities and operations.
